Winemaking Notes

- FRUIT** 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Bartolucci Vineyard on Dean York Lane in St. Helena
- VINEYARD** Located at the base of Spring Mountain, this old, head-pruned vineyard has been farmed by the Bartolucci family for three generations. With its gravelly soil and warmer micro-climate, this vineyard is ideally suited to growing Cabernet Sauvignon.
- WINEMAKING** The fruit was harvested from September 8th – 20th, with an average Brix of 26.5 degrees. The grapes were pressed off the skins 12-20 days after crushing and the wine was aged in small oak barrels for 20 months.
- AGING** French oak barrels (50% new wood)

Tasting Notes

Bold fruit, beautifully framed by French oak. Notes of cassis, black cherry and black tea, with red raspberry and allspice on the finish. A highly structured wine that is nicely balanced.
