WINEMAKING NOTES

FRUIT	100% Sauvignon Blanc, Honig Estate
VINEYARD	The fruit for this wine comes from Block One of our vineyard, next to the Napa River. The close proximity to the river's moisture aids in the natural occurrence of Botrytis, critical to a late harvest wine.
HARVEST	Harvested on November 7, 2007 Brix: 37.8 Residual sugar: 18.5% Alcohol: 11%
WINEMAKING	Barrel fermented in small oak barrels, stopped about half way through, then aged for 6 months.
BARRELS	French Oak (100% new wood)

TASTING NOTES

Aromas and flavors of honey, dried apricots, and citrus rind, layered with crème brulee and mineral. Luscious, with a rich, long finish and balanced acidity.
