



## 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon

### Winemaking Notes

- FRUIT** 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Campbell Vineyard on South Whitehall Lane in Rutherford.
- VINTAGE** "Classic" and "perfect" are just two accolades being bestowed upon the 2012 Napa Valley growing season and harvest. Textbook conditions saw near-ideal spring bud break, steady flowering, even fruit set, and a lengthy stretch of warm days and cool and often foggy nights during the long summer months. Late and light rains held off until Napa Valley's treasured wine grapes found optimal ripeness, bringing exceptional quality to the crush pad and into the cellar.
- VINEYARD** This Rutherford bench gem is located at the base of the western hills of Napa Valley. Well drained soil and perfect exposure produce classic Cabernet Sauvignon.
- HARVEST DATES** October 21, 2012  
Average Degrees Brix: 25.9
- WINEMAKING** The wine was pressed after 26 days on the skins and aged for 20 months in new French oak barrels. Bottled August 07, 2014
- Tasting Notes** Black cherry, currant, and raspberry layered with cinnamon and vanilla-caramel. Substantial tannins on the finish are beautifully balanced by a rich mid-palate and a lengthy, flavorful finish.
