Winemaking Notes

FRUIT 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Campbell Vineyard on South Whitehall Lane in Rutherford.

VINTAGE The beginning of the 2019 growing season was defined by copious rainfall and late soil moisture. The long, warm summer saw very few extreme heat events, with foggy mornings setting the stage for vibrant and expressive wines. The long, relatively mild finish to the season preserved freshness and finesse in the fruit, with great color, structure and soft tannins. 2019 promises to be an amazing vintage.

HARVEST DATES October 10, 2019
Average Degrees Brix: 25.9

WINEMAKING The fruit was picked, crushed, and fermented separately. After 24 days on skins, the wine was pressed and racked to new French barrels and allowed to age. Bottled May 19, 2021. 200 cases

AGING Aged for 18 months in new French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES On the nose, aromas of baked plum and cherry turnover emerge first followed by a hint of kirsch. Jammy red fruit with butterscotch and caramel notes hit first on the palate interwoven with a playful savory note reminiscent of garam marsala. Big tannins and toasty oak provide structure and added dimension to the wine. Drink through 2029 and beyond.
